- 10. Aids Awareness Rally:** In 2014-15 total 2200 students & 150 staff participated in the rally.



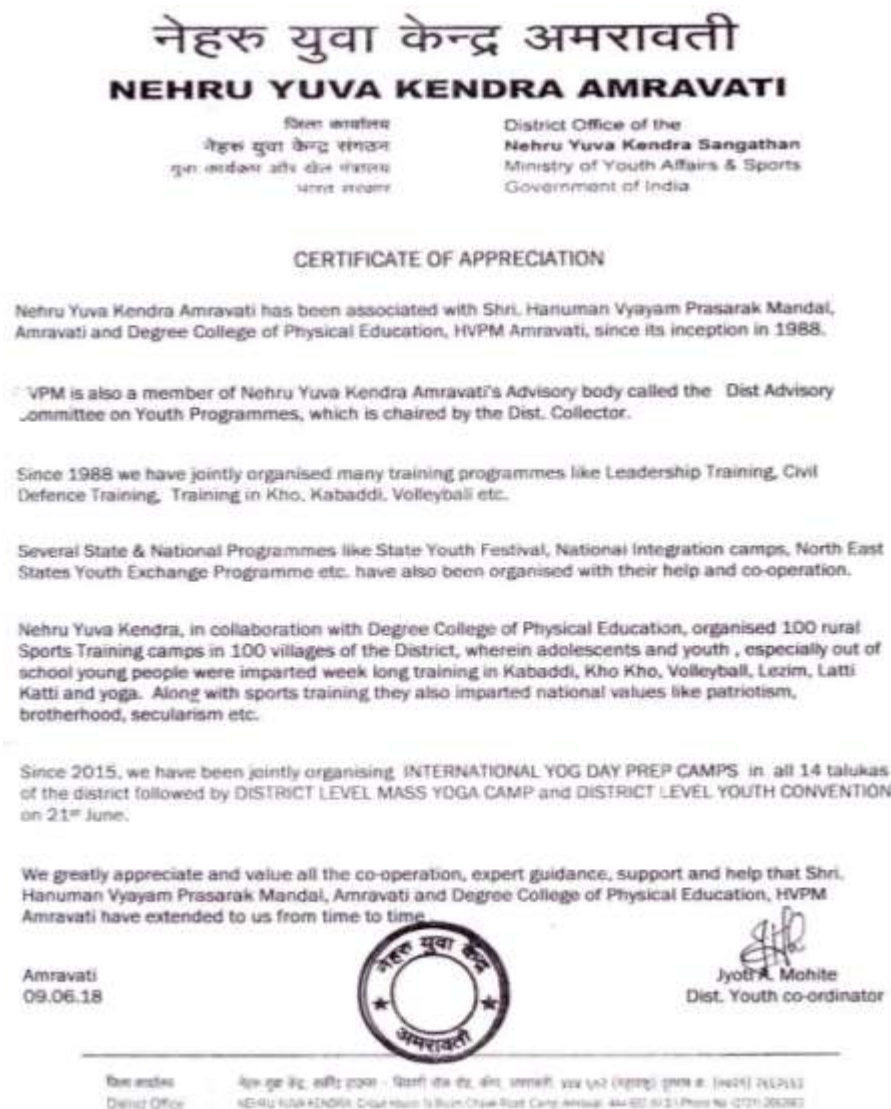

14. Dengue Awareness Rally: Dengue is a vector-borne disease that is a major public health threat. In 2018, there was a major Dengue outbreak in Amravati City. This rally was organized on 6th Sept 2018 in collaboration with Corporators, Municipal Corporation, N.S.S., Student Council of Degree College of Physical Education and Vidarbha Ayurved Mahavidyalaya.
